Empowering Youth and Women Across Kenya, Tanzania & Zambia

Farming for the Future – Maize, Rice & Soybeans

Rodrick Sanga is equipping youth and women with life skills in crop production, focusing on maize, rice, and soybeans. Through practical training and planning support, participants are guided in food production and grain trading for income. These staples not only address food security but also form a base for agricultural entrepreneurship in rural communities.



Youth Livelihood Support – Thika, Kenya (May 2025) Rodrick poses with a flock of goats mobilized and awarded to selected youth beneficiaries through a rigorous and competitive selection process aimed at promoting youth entrepreneurship in livestock farming.

Goats for Growth – Youth Livelihoods & Global Markets

Rodrick's goat rearing program targets youth unemployment by distributing 1,000 goats monthly. Each youth cooperative of 20 members receives 20 goats, after training in animal care, record keeping, and processing hides into value-added items like belts, shoes, and wallets. Goats, priced at \$50–\$100 each, offer both local and export market potential for young entrepreneurs.

Skate Boarding & Sports for Youth Development

In both urban and rural areas, Rodrick is using sports—particularly skirt boarding—as a tool for youth transformation. These programs build discipline, self-worth, and critical thinking, helping steer young people away from destructive habits while promoting health, creativity, and purpose-driven lifestyles.

Women in Seeds – Feeding Families, Securing Futures

Rodrick champions inclusive seed multiplication programs for women in partnership with Joas Chihangu of Seed Foundation Zambia. Together, they are making climate-resilient maize, rice, and legume seeds accessible and affordable. This allows women to grow food, nourish their families, and contribute to long-term nutrition and food security.



Social Entrepreneurship & Agricultural Aggregation – Mbeya, Tanzania (May 2025) Rodrick in Mbeya with an SME aggregator, promoting social entrepreneurship and crop aggregation models to strengthen market access and local value chains.

Financial Literacy & Social Discipline

Beyond farming, Rodrick empowers youth and women with capacity building in financial literacy and land management. Training addresses harmful habits like theft, drunkenness, gambling, and absenteeism. By promoting teamwork, transparency, and discipline, these sessions lay the foundation for sustainable entrepreneurship and responsible leadership in communities.
